

**Mumbai ASIAPACIFICON-2005 Fellowships of the  
International College of Surgeons (Indian Section)**

The International College of Surgeons (Indian Section) invites applications for the newly instituted “Mumbai ASIAPACIFICON-2005 Travelling Fellowships” for the year 2008.

**Aim:** The aim of these fellowship grants is to provide partial financial support to young surgeons visiting a centre in India or abroad to expand their knowledge / skills.

**Number and type of Fellowships**

Two Fellowships will be awarded each other

1. Mumbai ASIAPACIFICON-2005 Fellowship (National) - for visiting a centre in India
2. Mumbai ASIAPACIFICON-2005 Fellowship (International) -for visiting a centre overseas

**Fellowship Grant**

**MUMBAI ASIAPACIFICON-2005 National Fellowship** carries an award of **Rs. 15,000/-** & the **MUMBAI ASIAPACIFICON-2005 International Fellowship** carries an award of **Rs. 35,000/-**. This amount can be used in conjunction with any other grant the candidate may receive for supporting his/her visit. The grant has to be used in the year for which he/she is selected. Fifty percent of the fellowship grant would be awarded on selection and the remaining fifty percent will be given after the fellowship is completed and a report is submitted. Any default in utilising this grant will result in remaining grant being withheld & the awardees being asked to return the advance grant. Both the awardees will register for and attend the National Conference of the ICS-IS in the following year to receive the Fellowship Award and the Certificate of Honour.

**Eligibility criteria for application**

1. The applicant may belong to any branch of surgery or allied branches
2. He / she should preferably be a Fellow / Associate Fellow of the International College of Surgeons (Indian Section) in good standing
3. He / she must be under 40 years of age in the year of applying for the fellowship.
4. Candidates working in teaching / private hospitals or in private practice are eligible to apply.
5. He / she should have / possess a postgraduate qualification (M.S. / M.D. / D. N. B.) in the respective speciality

### **Application procedure:**

1. Prior to application for the Fellowship, the applicant should correspond with the Department / Institution he / she wishes to visit and obtain a letter confirming that he / she has been accepted for training / observership. The minimum period of visit to the centre should be 15 days. **Please note that the Fellowship cannot be availed solely for attending a conference.**
2. The typed / computer-printed application should comprise the following
  - a) Duly filled Fellowship application form (obtained from the ICS Office, Mumbai).
  - b) An up-to-date bio-data highlighting the contributions made by the candidate.
  - c) Letter of acceptance from the Head of Department / Centre of visit.
  - d) A single page write up about their suitability for the Fellowship and how they wish to apply the experience gained from the visit on their return.
  - e) Proof of age (copy of birth certificate / passport etc)
  - f) Four copies of all the above and any additional relevant documents should be forwarded to the Hon. Secretary, International College of Surgeons, Indian Section before 31st August of the year.
  - g) The Selection of the candidates shall be done by a duly appointed committee of the ICS-IS & its decision shall be final & binding.
  - h) The candidate may be required to come for an interview to Mumbai at his/her own expense.

### **After Completion of the Fellowship**

Within a month of completing the Fellowship, the candidate should submit a report of his visit to the Hon. Secretary of ICS-IS, along with a certificate from the Head of the Department / Institution confirming that he/she has undertaken the visit.
